#### Planning & Sequencing

A well-planned piece of writing with a good beginning, middle and a clear conclusion.

#### Writing

The ending refer back to the beginning and the transition between ideas is smooth. However, a greater variety of sentence structures need to be used.

#### SPaG

Good grasp on the medium of communication is expressed in grammatically correct, well-punctuated sentences.

#### Vocabulary

Good use of metaphor, simile and hyperbole has been done. Choice of words to describe is precise. A greater variety of figures of speech can be used.

#### Literary Devices

Good use of metaphor, simile and hyperbole has been done. Choice of words to describe is precise. A greater variety of figures of speech can be used.

### AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT

Use a variety of sentence structures please: try beginning with a verb or an adverb phrase: Being witty, he is able to lighten the mood in any tough situation.

Use more figurative language please: he is my partner in crime (metaphor); his sunshine smile (alliteration); despite warning him a million times (hyperbole); he grunts like a pig as he chuckles to himself (onomatopoeia and simile); etc.

Use of sensory language helps bring the picture alive in the reader's mind: he makes me feel safe and secure in his warm, affectionate hug; etc.

Use a variety of connectives instead of just using 'then, when, but, so, and': however, moreover, additionally, etc.

Use advanced punctuation please: brackets, colon, semicolon, question mark, exclamation mark. 'What a wonderful friend he is! Could I have asked for anyone better? Sensitive and gentle, naughty and boisterous: he is a perfect combination of these qualities.'

### RECOMMENDATIONS

Pay due attention to use of advanced punctuation and sentence variety for impact.
