Revise as 'A long time ago, he had a happy, loving family. Tragically, they were killed by an evil wizard, the most evil alive.'

Rewrite: From the top of the tree house he could see miles and miles away. The entire city lay spread before his eyes.

This should be a full stop

SP: starry

Use 'an' before vowels (a,e,i,o,u)

The sentence is still continuing, so use small t here

What is 'here' referring to?
